

# Supply of Medical Equipment to General Hospitals at Kilinochchi and Mullaitivu



**Scope of the Project:** Based on the request from the Government of Sri Lanka, the Project to supply 28 types of critical and non-critical high valued equipments to the General Hospitals at Kilinochchi and Mullaitivu was sanctioned by the Government of India with the objective to improve the medical facilities in the Government Hospitals.



**Project Cost:** LKR 117 million (26 Crore)

**Project Status:** Completed (2005-2011)

**Modalities of Implementation:** The project was implemented under the Small Development Project (SDP). The contract was awarded to eight companies in Sri Lanka through an open tender procedure. Ministry of Health, Northern Province was the nodal agency for this project.

**Equipment supplied:** 79 medical equipment have been installed in different department such as Operation Theatre, Intensive Care Unit, Pediatric unit, Laboratory and Obstetric unit of these hospitals at Kilinochchi and Mullaitivu ([click here to view the list of medical equipment supplied to the Hospitals](#))

**Impact:** The equipments supplied under the Project were formally handed over by the Hon'ble External Affairs Minister of India Shri. S.M.Krishna during his visit to Kilinochchi on 18th January 2012. The Project has improved the medical facilities of the General Hospitals at Kilinochci and Mullaitivu which together treat more than 500,000 patients every year.
