CORRIGENDUM



Reference Tender No. Col/COM/228/8/2011-Equip dated 05 July 2016 for Supply and Delivery of Farm Machineries, Mechanical Equipment, Computers, Furniture and Sports items for the Faculties of Engineering and Agriculture, University of Jaffna at Ariviyal Nagar, Kilinochchi.

Bidders may note the following changes in the Tender documents:

1.Tender Notice

Clause 2 - Interested bidders may purchase the Tender Documents from Project Officer (Development Cooperation) High Commission of India, 36-38, Galle Road, Colombo-03, between **05 July 2016** and **10 August 2016**, against payment of SLR 2,500 per package (non-refundable) in cash. **Indian bidder can purchase the tender document by submitting a demand draft valued USD 18 per package in favour of “High Commission of India, Colombo” payable at “State Bank of India, Colombo”.** These documents can also be seen from www.hcicolombo.org.

Clause 3 - The technical bid (Original & Duplicate) and the financial bid (Original & Duplicate) documents should be sealed by the bidder in separate covers duly superscribed and these four sealed covers are to be put in a bigger cover which should also be sealed and duly superscribed and marked **“Supply and Delivery of Farm Machineries, Mechanical Equipment, Computers, Furniture and Sports items for the Faculty of Engineering and Faculty of Agriculture, University of Jaffna at Ariviyal Nagar, Kilinochchi.”** The technical bids will be opened in presence of authorized representatives of bidders **at 1530 hrs on 12 August 2016** in the High Commission of India, Colombo, Sri Lanka. Sealed quotations may be submitted under the two bid system (technical and financial) by manufacturers or authorized dealers/sales agents of items mentioned in **Annexure A** (as per listed specifications) based in Sri Lanka or India. All tenders received after the deadline will be rejected.

Clause 6 - Bid may be submitted to Project Officer (Development Cooperation) High Commission of India, 36-38, Galle Road, Colombo-03 on or before **1500 hrs on 12 August 2016** and acknowledgement obtained.

Clause 7 - The technical bids will be opened in presence of authorized representatives of bidders **at 1530 hrs on 12 August 2016** in the High Commission of India, Colombo, Sri Lanka.

Clause 5 to Clause 7 as per the original tender document will now be referred as Clause 4 to Clause 6

2. Terms and Conditions

Clause 8 - OPENING OF BIDS: The sealed quotations (technical bids) will be opened in presence of authorized representatives of bidders at **1530 hrs on 12 August 2016** in the High Commission of India. After scrutiny of technical bids by the TEC, financial bids of only those bidders who qualify the technical evaluation will be opened at a time and date to be intimated later.

Clause 9 - EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)/Bid Security: Technical bids should contain EMD (May please refer clause 10) in the form of a Bank Guarantee drawn in favour of High Commission of India, Colombo. Alternatively, a standard bid guarantee (format as in **Annexure D**) issued by a commercial bank approved by the Central Bank of Sri Lanka, in favour of the High Commission of India, Colombo of this amount may be provided. The Bid Guarantee of all unsuccessful bidders will be released after the tender is finalized. The Bid Guarantee should be valid for **a minimum period of 135 days** from the date of opening of tenders. **Earnest Money Deposit/ Bid Security must be submitted with the technical bids (in the same envelope).** Indian bidder may submit EMD in US Dollar at the official rate of exchange **1 INR = 2.1337 SLR, 1 INR = 68.25 USD** drawn in favour of the “High Commission of India, Colombo”, payable at “State Bank of India, Colombo”. Bidders are requested to intimate the concerned Bank Guarantee issuing authority to send a confirmation to the High Commission of India at dc.colombo@mea.gov.in with the following information (This is mandatory)

Clause 10 - PACKAGES FOR BIDDING: Sri Lankan bidders may bid for one or more of the following packages, while Indian bidders can bid for only package 1 and package 2. (Details in **Annexure A**). The EMD payments may be made accordingly.

Clause 19 - PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE: The successful bidder shall submit, within **fourteen** working days after the award of tender, a Performance Guarantee provided by a commercial bank or an insurance agency approved by the Central Bank of Sri Lanka, of an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the value of order, drawn in favor of the “High Commission of India, Colombo” for the due execution of the contract within the specified period. **Indian bidder may submit the performance guarantee in US Dollar at the official rate of exchange drawn in favour of the “High Commission of India, Colombo”, payable at “State Bank of India, Colombo”,** for the due execution of the contract within the specified period. The Performance Guarantee should be valid for a period of **150 days** from the date of award. If the Performance Guarantee is not submitted within **14 days** of the letter of award, the award will be cancelled and the Guarantee will be forfeited. The EMD of the bidder, whose tender is accepted, will be discharged when the said bidder’s Performance Guarantee has been accepted. Bidders are requested to intimate the concerned Bank Guarantee issuing authority to send a confirmation to the High Commission of India at dc.colombo@mea.gov.in with the following information

Clause 8 to Clause 23 as per the original tender document will now be referred as Clause 6 to Clause 21

Please Note:

1. As per the MOU signed by Government of India and Government of Sri Lanka, customs duty, VAT and other taxes will be borne by Government of Sri Lanka.

2. Indian companies will have to quote only in Sri Lankan Rupees (SLR). If selected, the payment will be made in SLR. In case the Indian companies want the payment in INR or USD, the payment will be made in INR or USD at the prevailing official rate of exchange.

3. For package 1 & package 2, both the Sri Lankan and Indian companies are required to quote the price without custom duties, VAT & other taxes as provided in the price schedule form (Annexure A).
