Scope of the Project : Based on the request from Government of Sri Lanka, Government of India is undertaking a project to supply 150 boats and fishing equipment for fishermen of Mullaitivu.

Project Cost : SLR 100 million(INR 4.7 Crores)

Modalities of Implementation: The project is being implemented under the Small Development Project (SDP) model. The MoU was signed at the Ministry of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources Development by
