Procurement of Medical Equipment and Furniture for 200 - bed Ward Complex at District General Hospital, Vavuniya



Scope of the Project : On receipt of a request from Government of Sri Lanka, Government of India has agreed to provide medical equipment and furniture for 200- bed ward complex at the District General Hospital, Vavuniya. The equipment and furniture shall include items like wall oxygen system, portable ventilators, Multipara monitors, Pulse Oximeters, Anaesthesia Machine, Diathermy, Incubators for infants, Ultrasound Scanners, refrigerators, beds, bed-side lockers, patient trolleys, etc. This 200- bed ward complex was built with the Government of India assistance in

2015.

Project Cost : SLR 100 million (INR 4.7 Crores)

Implementing Partners:

Modalities of Implementation: The Project has been undertaken under the Small Development Project (SDP) model. An MoU for this project was signed during the visit of Hon'ble Prime Minister of Sri Lanka, Mr. Ranil Wickremesinghe to India on 15 September 2015. To monitor the implementation of the project, a Project Steering Committee comprising of Secretary, Ministry of Health, Nutrition & Indigenous Medicine (Co-Chairman), Deputy High Commissioner of India (Co-Chairman), Secretary, Ministry of Health, Northern Province, Regional Director of Health Services, Vavuniya, a representative each from the External Resources Department and Provincial Directorate of Health Services, Northern Province have been constituted.

Beneficiaries : Patients from Vavuniya, Mullaitivu and adjoining areas.
